<b>Name of creator</b>	Busby & Sheddens [Old Folks'] Friendship Club
<b>Administrative/ biographical history</b>	The Busby and Sheddens Old Folks Friendship Club was formed c. 1956 and appears to have been active until 2002.
<b>Archival history</b>	The records of the club were deposited with East Renfrewshire Libraries sometime between 2002 and 2006. They were stored at the Department's store at Neilston Leisure Centre
<b>Immediate source of acquisition</b>	The records were transferred from East Renfrewshire Council Libraries as part of accession 2006/02 on 20/9/2006.
<b>Scope and content</b>	Minutes, programs and financial records of the Club; Records of Age Concern Eastwood; publications and ephemera of local historical interest.
<b>Appraisal, destruction and scheduling information</b>	All records which transferred to the archives have been retained, except for some non-local ephemera.
