Our focus..... Your priorities

INTRODUCTION

This report covers progress we have made in dealing with your priorities for the **Eaglesham & Waterfoot Community Council** area for the period **1st September to 30th September 2017**. A list of these priorities is provided at the end of this report for your reference.

This report aims to highlight emerging issues in your area, and to provide crime prevention advice and guidance to the members of the Community Council and to the residents that they represent.

This document does not provide a comprehensive statistical breakdown of numbers of crimes reported as this does not provide any context for the reader.

INFORMATION

1. Assault & Violent Crime

There have been no serious assault or common assaults in public in your community council area during the period under review.

2. Drug Dealing & Drug Use

On the evening of the 19th September, officers carrying out pro-active patrols found a 19 year old male in possession of a quantity of herbal cannabis at Whitelee Windfarm.

3. Drunk or Disorderly Behaviour

In early September a number of vandalisms occurred involving the use of spray paint.

Overnight on the 9th into the 10th September, the Eglinton Arms Hotel was spray painted. Over the following 2 to 3 days, a total of 11 cars were vandalised with spray paint in Park Crescent and Holehouse Road. There were no witnesses and no CCTV is available.

There have been no further incidents since then.

4. Housebreaking & Other Theft

There have been no housebreakings in your community council area during the period under review.

CRIME PREVENTION

We remind all residents to be vigilant in regards to locking and securing their property at all times of day and night. Opportunistic thieves continue to target insecure premises across East Renfrewshire.

NEWS

You may be aware of the “Your View Counts” survey that was launched in 2016 by Police Scotland. The first year results of this survey were published previously and are being used to inform the local policing plan for East Renfrewshire and East Renfrewshire Council’s Local Improvement Plan.
