How we support our veteran customers

We have a dedicated team of Armed Forces and Veterans Champions across our network of branch and offices.

Their role is to establish rapport with the individual to understand their career goals and support needs and through effective case management, support the individual on their journey to employment.

Support includes:

Establishing career goals and barriers

One-to-one discussion and the use of a specialist profiling tool. Identify transferable skills, career goals and any barriers that stand in the way of getting there.

Preparation

Support and guidance to help write a great CV, complete application forms and prepare for interviews.

Development

Support sessions and modules, helping with confidence building, skills development and tackling other barriers to work.

Specialist support

Additional intervention where required, through our network of specialist partners.

Work experience and tasters

This could include one day tasters to narrow career goals, followed by a short work placement to confirm if it's the right career path.

Finding a job

Advice and guidance on where, and how, to look and apply for jobs, with access to the latest vacancies with our employer partners.

In-work support

Helping the veteran to make a confident start in their new job and continue to progress and develop their career.



Our Armed Forces and Veterans Champions also provide individuals with a link to a network of specialist organisations providing additional intervention where required, as well as access to employment opportunities through our employer partnerships.

The service is delivered by Vocational Rehabilitation Consultants who are members of the Vocational Rehabilitation Association.




Workplace Mental Health Support Service
