**1. Matters arising from Previous Minutes and Approved.**

**2 .POLICE REPORT.** PC Raymond Jeffries.

*Homes broken into.*

- *On 2<sup>nd</sup> January, a private nursery premises was broken into and property stolen. 3 Youths are subject to a report to the Procurator Fiscal.*
- *On 19<sup>th</sup> November, an unidentified person broke into a home in Hawthorn Road and stole property.*

*Antisocial behaviour and disorder.*

- *On 17<sup>th</sup> November, an egg was thrown at a house in Cartside Road.*
- *Two reports of cars being vandalised in Field Road on 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> December. Remain undetected.*
- *On 28<sup>th</sup> December, a fire was deliberately set outside Cartsidebridge Evangelical Church, causing damage to the church door. Enquiries ongoing.*
- *On 4<sup>th</sup> January, a man was arrested after reports of threatening and abusive behaviour in Hawthorn Road. A report is being submitted to the Procurator Fiscal.*

*Violent Crime.*

- *On 11<sup>th</sup> December, officers attended a report of a man causing a nuisance in Viaduct Road.*
- *A police officer was assaulted, causing facial injury. A 35 year old man has now appeared in court with various offences, including "police assault" and the possession of drugs with intent to supply.*

*Drug dealing and misuse.*

- *No further drug offences have been recorded.*
