Climate presentation and discussion	<p>The Chair welcomed Andy Dick from ERC to the meeting. Andy presented the attached</p> <p> Get to Zero, NeSt.pdf</p> <p>There will be a public consultation in September 2022 and there will be a call for bodies to be involved in a Climate Partnership to help with the strategy.</p> <p>Discussion was held following the presentation and some points of note include: Community engagement for local transport strategy is planned. Some of the area is Conservation so needs considered. 20 minute neighbourhood important to residents. Inclusion of all needs considered, finding balance to ensure all population involved. ERC could consider creating a reliable information page as difficult to find best information for home energy improvements.</p>

Minutes from previous meeting agreed	Some discussion around length of minutes from meeting in April as longer than usual. Noted that difficult to shorten by VP and V McCulloch without losing some important detail. Minutes from April accepted as correct, proposer BL and seconded by DM.	
Outstanding actions from previous meeting	Overlee hydro - feeling that if applicant is still wishing support then can invite to next meeting. Noted this has been an outstanding item for some time. Leaflet – Outreach subgroup will press on with this. DM will take forward design and VP will do costs to present at next meeting. Expenses process – JT and GK will take forward as new term UK parliamentary boundaries letter – members believe this consultation is closed so no action required.	SM to email DM/VP JT/GK
Financial matters/treasurer update	Account signatories to be updated. JT will meet with GK and confirm plan – likely office bearers to be signatories	JT
Councillor update	The new councillors for the ward were welcomed and congratulated on their success. Cllr Ireland advised that further work is now completed on dropped kerbs and bollards at the junction of Linnpark Avenue and Clarkston Road. The first stage of clearing the felled trees in Overlee Park now complete, awaiting Scottish Water and Network Rail to finalise details for next stage. There is a proposal to look at Clarkston Road as a potential for cycle lane development – funding application to Sustrans to be done for July. Cllr Pragnell advised that the area of Clarkston, Netherlee and Williamwood is due to have a “Local Action Plan” review and the aim for starting is October 2022. The 1 st Stamperland Guides have secured new premises after Stamperland Church closes.
