Chair's Update</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Hub@Clarkston</u> <p>No update as yet</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parklets – report update <p>Request from ERC for feedback - RN will go back to Frances Tonner regarding our input and to clarify requirements of the CCC within the process. LD highlighted that at the meeting on the 11/01/2023 CKP advised us that that the proposal was potentially being taken to cabinet on 23/02/2023. The option that Cllrs voted for was to revamp the current parklets set up and remove the one outside the train station to make this a disabled car parking space.</p> <p>This is obviously conflicting with the request from Frances Tonner for feedback from us re: the new options outlined in her email.</p> <p>Action: RN to contact France Tonner and find out what is happening re: Parklets consultation and options.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gas Explosion Memorial <p>GC has a meeting with KO's office to push this forward. KO was coming up with some comms for the community to gain feedback and views on the memorial ideas.</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Place Based Investment programme RN to look at posting a Facebook advert for the PBI • Trees at Mearns Rd – update from LF CKP: advised that the council are keen for us to go ahead. LF stressed that the question from the last meeting was about who’s responsibility it was to replace the trees that had been removed. LF is going to get in touch with the council again re: whose responsibility it is. CCC are looking to do this in support with the council, rather than just being told we can put trees wherever we want. • Wind down of CCC and attraction of future members RN updated on the timeline for Community Council elections, as supplied by ERC. There will be no meeting in July and we will wind down after the AGM in June. RN is putting a post on the Facebook page again to update for new members and hosting an informal information evening for prospective members. CK emailed St. Joseph’s, but it hasn’t gone in the bulletin – CK will follow up. CK noted he was likely to stay on if CCC reforms.

We received lots of support online and 6 responses from the leaflet drop: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1 in support of the move - 3 concerned about youth disorder - 1 couple were wary but understanding so asked if we can move the seats to the other side of the park <p>Invoice is being sent and we will pay for the seating prior to installation, then we can meet Kompan on site for installation plans.</p> • Roads updates No new information from roads re: road closure
